KDAC Young Eagles Terms and Conditions

Kapiti Aero Club offers up to 9 young men and women the opportunity to join the Young Eagles Program. The objective of the Young Eagles Program is to Introduce Aviation to young people and to provide an opportunity for them to experience and gain knowledge in the different sectors within aviation. Hopefully this will help them make a knowledgeable decision about their future.

Those selected will experience flights in light aircraft and participate in visits to aviation facilities around the Wellington Region. These activities are supported by the Kapiti Aero Club, its members and sponsors of the program. Photos of Young Eagles participating in these activities may be used by KDAC and featured on the KDAC and Young Eagles social media pages.

The Young Eagles program is planned to run fortnightly on Sunday, beginning in August/September. Activities are normally 2-5 hours in duration and are held at, or start from the Kapiti Aero Club. Some activities are weather dependent and may be cancelled or postponed. The program may be amended at the discretion of the KDAC Young Eagles Flight Leaders.

The Young Eagles programme may include one or more flights in aircraft operated by Kapiti Districts Aero Club or its members. These flights may be piloted by unpaid volunteers who have donated their time and the costs of operating an aircraft to provide Young Eagles participants with the chance to experience flight in light aircraft. All pilots will be appropriately licensed, experienced and approved by the club. A volunteer pilot may ask for a contribution toward the costs of a flight but that contribution will not exceed the total cost of the flight divided by the total number of persons onboard, including the pilot.

Parental help with transport may be required for away trips.

Successful applicants may be eligible to compete for flying scholarships from Flying NZ to be used for flying lessons at KDAC. The minimum age for application is 15 years old.

To participate, the applicant;

- Must be aged between 14 to 17 years;
- Must have paid the \$175.00 Participation fee* (if successful in being selected);
- Must have minimal flight experience/training;
- Must be physically capable of getting in and out of aircraft; and
- Completed all parts of this application form including references, introduction letter and parent/guardians permission.

* The Participation fee will be credited to a flying account that will be opened for each Young Eagle. Balances in a flying account are non-refundable. If for any reason an event does not go ahead or is staffed by club volunteers thus reducing the cost to the Young Eagle, a balance may be left in the Flying Account. This balance may be used for private flight training by the Young Eagle.

Parents/ Guardians

I understand that the Young Eagles program includes flight experiences with qualified flight instructors and licensed pilots, and other aviation related activities. These activities are run in accordance with CAA rules and regulations.

I certify that I am the candidate's legal guardian and I give him/ her permission to participate in the program.

I agree to not hold the Kapiti Aero Club or any of its representatives or employees, or any other party involved in providing the Young Eagles program liable/ responsible for any personal injury or damage that may result from the candidate's participation in any part of the Young Eagles program.
