KDAC Young Eagles Terms and Conditions

Kapiti Aero Club offers up to 10 young men and women the opportunity to join the Young Eagles Program. The objective of the Young Eagles Program is to Introduce Aviation to young people and to provide an opportunity for them to experience and gain knowledge in the different sectors within aviation. Hopefully this will help them make a knowledgeable decision about their future.

Those selected will experience flights in light aircraft and participate in visits to aviation facilities around the Wellington Region. These activities are supported by the Kapiti Aero Club, its members and sponsors of the program. Photos of Young Eagles participating in these activities may be used by KDAC and featured on the KDAC and Young Eagles social media pages.

The Young Eagles program is planned to run every 4 weeks at the weekends, beginning in January. Activities are normally 2-6 hours in duration. Some activities are weather dependent and may be cancelled or postponed. The program may be amended at the discretion of the KDAC Young Eagles Flight Leaders. The club aims to have confirmation/updated information sent out 2 weeks prior to each activity/event. Events and activities are scheduled to be during school terms and to not include any public holiday weekends.

As part of the program, each Young Eagle will receive a shirt, a cap and some other aviation items. Once a Young Eagle has received their shirt, they are required to wear it at all future Young Eagles events, and are encouraged to wear it any other time they are at the club.

The Young Eagles programme may include one or more flights in aircraft operated by Kapiti Districts Aero Club or its members. These flights will be piloted by volunteers who are donating their time to provide Young Eagles participants with the chance to experience flight in light aircraft. All pilots have been subject to a Police check, hold appropriate aviation licenses, are experienced and have been approved by the club's Principal Instructor.

The use of a cell phone and the taking of photos and/or videos while on a Young Eagles flight must be approved by the Pilot in Command of that flight. Photos and videos must not be published on social media without the express permission of the Young Eagles Flight Leader.

Parental help with land transport may be required for day trips.

Successful applicants may be eligible to compete for flying scholarships from Flying NZ to be used for flying lessons at KDAC. The minimum age for application is 15 years old.

To participate an applicant is required to;

- Be aged between 15 to 18 years;
- Have paid the \$180.00 Participation fee* (if successful in being selected);
- Pay \$40 per return flight trip**;
- Have minimal flight experience/training;
- Be physically capable of getting in and out of aircraft; and
- Complete all parts of this application form including introduction letter and parent/guardian's permission.

* The Participation fee and all flight costs are non-refundable in the case of the Young Eagle having to pull out of the program

** The current program for 2021 has 4 flight trips planned
