Kāpiti Aero Club Young Eagles Terms and Conditions

Kāpiti Aero Club offers a small group of young people the opportunity to join the Young Eagles Programme each year. The objective of the Young Eagles Programme is to introduce Aviation to youths and to provide an opportunity for them to experience and gain knowledge in the different sectors within aviation. Hopefully this will help them make a knowledgeable decision about their future.

Those selected will experience flights in light aircraft in the Cook Strait Region and participate in visits to aviation facilities around the Wellington Region. These activities are supported by the Kāpiti Aero Club, its members and sponsors of the programme. Photos of Young Eagles participating in these activities may be used by Kāpiti Aero Club and Flying NZ and featured on the Kāpiti Aero Club and Young Eagles social media pages.

The Young Eagles programme is planned to run roughly once a month on the weekends, beginning in January. Activities are normally 1-6 hours in duration. Some activities are weather dependent and may be cancelled or postponed. The programme may be amended at the discretion of the Kāpiti Aero Club Young Eagles Flight Leaders. The club aims to have confirmation/updated information sent out 2 weeks prior to each activity/event. Events and activities are scheduled to be during school terms and to not include any public holiday weekends.

As part of the programme, each Young Eagle will receive a shirt, a cap and some other aviation items. Once a Young Eagle has received their shirt, they are required to wear it at all future Young Eagles events, and are encouraged to wear it any other time they are at the club.

The Young Eagles programme will include one or more flights in aircraft operated by Kāpiti Aero Club or its members. These flights will be piloted by volunteers who are donating their time, aircraft and other costs to provide Young Eagles participants with the chance to experience flight in light aircraft. All pilots have been subject to a police check, hold appropriate aviation licences, are experienced and have been approved by the club's Principal Instructor.

The use of a mobile phone and the taking of photos and/or videos while on a Young Eagles flight must be approved by the Pilot in Command of that flight. Certain Young Eagles activities take place at security sensitive locations, photos and videos must not be taken at these locations without the express written permission of the Young Eagles Flight Leader.

Parental help with land transport may be required for some trips.

Successful applicants may be eligible to apply for flying scholarships from Flying NZ to be used for flying lessons at Kāpiti Aero Club.

To participate an applicant is required to;

- Be aged between 15 to 18 years;
- Have paid the \$250.00 Participation fee* (if successful in being selected);
- Pay \$50 per return flight trip**;
- Not hold an aviation licence;
- Be physically capable of getting in and out of aircraft; and
- Complete all parts of this application form including introduction letter and parent/guardian's permission.

* The Participation fee and all paid flight costs are non-refundable in the case of the Young Eagle having to pull out of the program

** The current program for 2024 has 4 flight trips planned
